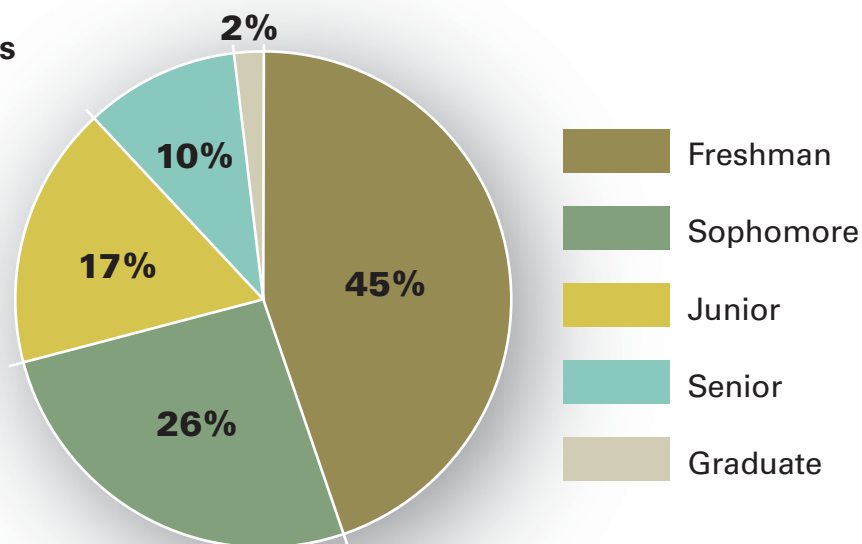


HOUSING

EXISTING CONDITIONS TODAY

- UC Santa Cruz houses the highest percentage of students on campus of any UC campus.
- Since 2011–12, the campus has limited its room and board rates for student housing to annual increases of 3% or less—half the average increase of off-campus options.
- In fall 2016, the campus provided 9,387 student bed spaces, which was 1,336 beds more than previous, agreed-to goals.
- Nearly all first-year students live in campus housing, and they are guaranteed a place on campus for at least two years.
- The current housed student population is approximately 71% lower division (fresh/soph), 26.7% upper division, and 2.3% graduate students.
- UC Santa Cruz is currently undertaking Student Housing West, a new building project that will add 3,000 new beds for students by 2022.
